- Provide a letter of recommendation by the student's academic advisor, department chair, or faculty member with which the student completed coursework
- Completed application form including the completion of two required essays
- A conference call interview may be expected of the finalists and will be scheduled by the Scholarship Committee of the Indiana Women in Public Finance
